Dear Mr. Gibbs:

On July 29, 2004, Public Citizen filed with the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) a letter expressing several concerns with the electric license granted to Reliant Energy Solutions East, LLC (“Reliant”). In its letter, Public Citizen alleges, among other things, that significant material changes should prompt the Commission to revoke Reliant’s license. The specifics of those allegations are indicated in the enclosed copy of Public Citizen’s July 27, 2004 letter.

Pursuant to the Public Utility Companies Article, §3-102, *Md. Ann. Code*, the Commission hereby directs Reliant to respond to Public Citizen’s letter within 10 days. Accordingly, Reliant shall file its response with the Commission on or before August 19, 2004. A copy of Reliant’s response shall be served on Public Citizen.
