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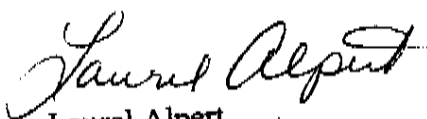

Dear Ms. Grier:

Thank you for the letter from Ambassador Zoellick to Governor Owens requesting that Colorado offer the same coverage of state-level government procurement to Panama and the Andean countries of Colombia, Ecuador and Peru that Colorado has already agreed to provide under the Government Procurement Agreement and other Free Trade Agreements. After reviewing this issue, Governor Owens agrees to Ambassador Zoellick's request to offer these countries, where appropriate, the same treatment. We understand that this request involves no additional commitments requiring Colorado to change its current government procurement practices and simply allows other countries to be added on the basis of reciprocity. Colorado's agreement is contingent upon existing state laws that govern purchasing requirements for state agencies.
