The U.S. International Trade Commission, the government's own agency that usually provides very rosy estimates of trade pact effects, says the Korea deal will increase our trade deficit. The job loss estimate is 159,000 for just the first seven years.

USITC also identified seven key losing industrial sectors – autos (including auto parts) and electronics will lose hundreds of millions of dollars each. Apparel and textiles, as well as transportation equipment, such as trains, are also losers. The U.S. metal products sector, which includes screws, also, well, gets screwed.
