Subject: Meeting in Nigeria on the proposed Enron emergency power project

Mr. Ansu

Enron is seeking, with the assistance of the U. S. Government, to encourage the Nigerian Government to call for a 3 party meeting - the Nigerian Government, the World Bank and Enron, to make sure the concerns raised by the Bank have been heard and taken into account in the context of the negotiations between the Government and ourselves. It is my understanding that senior officials in the World Bank Group are in favor of such a meeting taking place as soon as possible.

I am writing to ask when your staff would be available for such a meeting, presumably in Nigeria. If asked by the Nigerian Government to participate. Also, who at the World Bank should the request be made to. I would imagine the Bank representative in country would be an addressee, but is there anyone else who should be specifically identified?

I would appreciate getting this information as quickly as possible so that the U.S. Government request can go forward as specifically as possible.

Thank you for your assistance on this issue.
