Petitioning is explicitly prohibited within 50 feet of polling places. It is unclear whether petitioning is allowed within 50 to 300 feet of the polling area.

The law reads:

"26-7-108: No person shall be allowed to electioneer within three hundred (300) feet of any ballot box while an election is in progress, nor shall any person or persons, except election officials and other persons authorized by law, be allowed within fifty (50) feet of any ballot box while an election is in progress. No printed material other than that provided by the election board shall be publicly placed or exposed within three hundred (300) feet of any ballot box, while an election is in progress."

Please note, the prohibition on "exposed" printed material is quite vague, and "electioneering" is undefined.
