On behalf of the 600,000 active members of the Communications Workers of America (CWA) I urge you to cosponsor the Trade Reform, Accountability, Development and Employment Act (TRADE Act).

CWA strongly supports the vision of trade policy contained within the TRADE Act. The TRADE Act has been introduced by Congressman Mike Michaud (H.R. 6180). Over 60 Members of Congress joined as original cosponsors prior to introduction.
