

<u>Latest NHTSA Timelines Shorter than SAFETEA Schedule</u> <u>for Safety Rulemakings</u>

NHTSA Plans Same as Bill on Merits of Safety Goals, Need for New Rules; Show Agency Can More than Meet SAFETEA Rulemaking Schedule

Proposed: 2006 Final Rule: 2007 Side-window occupant containment performance requirement	Proposed: June 30, 2008 Final Rule: October 2009 Rulemaking to reduce complete or partial ejection of occupants; consider ejection mitigation alternatives

Proposed: May 2004 Final Rule: 2006 Upgraded side-impact protection	Final Rule: July 1, 2008 Standard designed to enhance occupant protection in side-impact crashes
