Re: HB 65 by Rep. J. Johnson - Supporting testimony of Public Citizen

Dear Chairman Landgraf and members of the committee:

Public Citizen appreciates the opportunity to testify in support of HB 65 by Representative Jarvis Johnson, relating to the requirements for notice of a standard permit for certain concrete plants.

This bill is intended to provide notice to all households within 880 yards of a permit application for a standard permit for a concrete batch plant.

Under current law, notice of permit applications is provide via publication in a paper of record in the nearest community. Permit notices are kept by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality in regional offices and in a central file room in Austin. Air quality permit applications also provide notice by sign posting at the physical location of a proposed facility.

Current notice practices provide limited notices to neighbors of a proposed concrete batch plant. In practice, residents are often unaware of a proposed facility until after a permit has been issued and construction begins.

HB 65 would provide mailed notice to all households within 880 yards of a proposed facility.

This will increase local awareness of permit applications and facilitate public participation. In our experience, a more robust public participation process leads to a better relationship between the facility and its neighbors.

We support HB 65 because it will improve public participation by providing mailed notice of permit applications for concrete batch plants.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Proposed Air Quality Permit No. 131789

APPLICATION. Concrete Pros Ready Mix Inc., has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for the amendment of Permit No. 131789. This application would authorize modification of a Concrete Batch Plant located at 4005 Swingle Road, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77047. This link to an electronic map of the site or facility's general location is provided as a public courtesy and not part of the application or notice. The proposed facility will emit the following air contaminants: particulate matter including (but not limited to) aggregate, cement, road dust, and particulate matter with diameters of 10 microns or less and 2.5 microns or less.

The executive director has completed the administrative and technical reviews of the application and determined that the application meets all of the requirements of a standard permit authorized by 30 TAC § 116.611, which would establish the conditions under which the plant must operate. The executive director has made a preliminary decision to issue the registration because it meets all applicable rules.

PUBLIC COMMENT/PUBLIC MEETING. You may submit public comments to the Office of the Chief Clerk at the address below. The TCEQ will consider all public comments in developing a final decision on the application. A public meeting will be held and will consist of two parts, an Informal Discussion Period and a Formal Comment Period. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing under the Administrative Procedure Act. During the Informal Discussion Period, the public will be encouraged to ask questions of the applicant and TCEQ staff concerning the permit application. The comments and questions submitted orally during the Informal Discussion Period will not be considered before a decision is reached on the permit application, and no formal response will be made. Responses will be provided orally during the Informal Discussion Period. During the Formal Comment Period on the permit application, members of the public may state their formal comments orally into the official record. At the conclusion of the comment period, all formal comments will be considered before a decision is reached on the permit application. A written response to all formal comments will be prepared by the executive director and will be sent to each person who submits a formal comment or who requested to be on the mailing list for this permit application and provides a mailing address. Only relevant and material issues raised during the Formal Comment Period can be considered if a contested case hearing is granted on this permit application.
