This should include a list of meetings and any materials received or produced by the before mentioned parties pertaining to the acquisition of Pepco Holding Inc by Exelon Corporation, including emails, email file attachments, and any notes or materials exchanged during any meetings.

*If there are any fees for searching or copying these records, please inform me if the cost will exceed \$100.00. However, I would also like to request a waiver of all fees in that the disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest and will contribute significantly to the public's understanding of Exelon's efforts to take over local utility Pepco. **Public Citizen, Inc is a not-for-profit incorporated in the District of Columbia. Our mission is to promote sustainable, reliable and affordable energy policies on behalf of our more than 400,000 members and supporters across the country, including DC residents.** This information is not being sought for commercial purposes, as any information we receive from this request we will share with the public, free of charge.*

The District of Columbia Freedom of Information Act requires a response within 15 business days. If access to the records I am requesting will take longer, please contact me with information about when I might expect copies or the ability to inspect the requested records.

If you deny any, or all of this request, please cite each specific exemption you feel justifies the refusal to release the information and notify me of the appeal procedures available to me under the law.
