MINUTE ENTRY

The Court has read and considered Plaintiffs' Motion for Order to Show Cause filed September 11, 2013. When a non-party objects to a subpoena duces tecum, Rule 45(c)(5)(B)(iii), Ariz.R.Civ.P., tells us that the appropriate motion to file is a motion to compel under Rule 37(a), not a motion for order to show cause for contempt. Additionally, the rule requires compliance with Rule 37(a)(2)(C), but no such separate statement of moving counsel appears to have been filed here. Based on the foregoing,

**IT IS ORDERED** denying Plaintiff's Motion for Order to Show Cause.

ALERT: The Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2011-140 directs the Clerk's Office not to accept paper filings from attorneys in civil cases. Civil cases must still be initiated on paper; however, subsequent documents must be eFiled through AZTurboCourt unless an exception defined in the Administrative Order applies.
