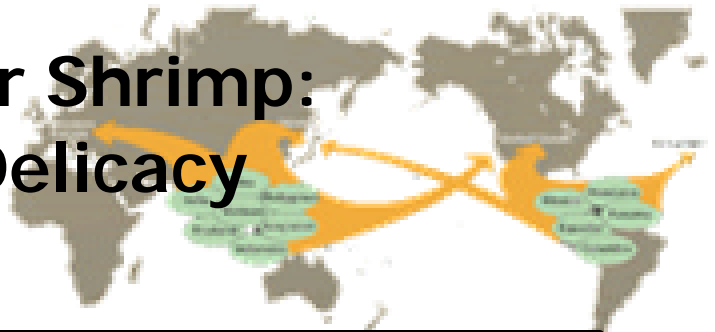


Farming the Seas for Shrimp: The Devastating Delicacy
