## OFFER-OF JUDGMENT

Pursuant to Rule 68 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure; Defendants Dr. Herbert Nevyas and Dr. Anita Nevyas-Wallace ("the Nevyases") hereby offer to allow judgment to be entered in favor of plaintiff Dominic Morgan ("Morgan") in this action, as follows:

- - (2) The Nevyases will stipulate to the Court's entry of an order to that effect, and will support the Court's continuing jurisdiction to enforce that Order, if the Court agrees to exercise continuing jurisdiction in this matter.

Acceptance of this offer and satisfaction of this judgment shall release all of Morgan's claims against the Nevyases, including but not limited to any and all claims for damages, costs of suit, interest, and/or attorneys' fees. If the offer is accepted, a notice of acceptance is to be served on the Nevyases' counsel and filed with the Court.

This offer of judgment is made for the purposes specified in Rule 68 and is not be construed either as an admission that the Nevyases are liable in this action or that Morgan has suffered any damage.

This offer of judgment shall not be filed with the Court unless: (a) accepted; or (b) in a proceeding to determine fees and costs.

Pursuant to Rule 68(d), if Morgan does not accept this offer of judgment, and any judgment that Morgan finally obtains is not more favorable than this offer, Morgan must pay the costs the Nevyases incur after this offer was made.
