*The U.S.-Colombia and U.S.-Panama Free Trade Agreements have been negotiated and have been signed by the respective executive branches. However, these agreements have not yet been ratified by the U.S. Congress. Some in Congress are asking the U.S. Trade Representative to re-negotiate portions of the trade agreements as a condition for ratification. If the agreements are re-opened and re-negotiated, the list of states could be subject to change. The information regarding states listed as bound to these two pending agreements is based on letters from governors and other state officials obtained through a Freedom of Information Act request.
