Petitioning is explicitly prohibited within 100 yards of polling places.

The law reads:

"22-26-113: Electioneering too close to a polling place or absentee polling place under W.S. 22-9-125 when voting is being conducted, consists of any form of campaigning, including the display of campaign signs or distribution of campaign literature, the soliciting of signatures to any petition or the canvassing or polling of voters, except exit polling by news media, within one hundred (100) yards of the building in which the polling place is located."

"22-13-103: (a) Judges of election have the duty and authority to preserve order at the polls by any necessary and suitable means.

(b) Except where physically impossible, a space of twenty (20) feet around voting booths and voting machines shall be kept clear of all persons except voters marking ballots, election officials discharging their duties and challengers acting under legal authority."
